REM: If the question asks you to answer a question about DEVELOPMENT it means ALL PIES!

If the question asks you about a particular PIES for example INTELLECTUAL (I) than that is how you answer the questions, only about intellectual development.

LOOK AT THE MARKS FOR EACH QUESTION THIS INDICATES HOW MANY ANSWERS THEY ARE EXPECTING FROM YOU.

EG: If the question is worth 2 marks it is asking you to complete the answer with an explanation or the effect on that person.

For example:

What are the effects on Stephens's development by starting a new course at university? (2)

Attending education will help Stephens's intellectual development (1) because he will be learning new skills and learning new information. (1)
