

YEAR 7 FINAL ASSESSMENTS IN SPANISH

MODULE: MI CIUDAD (My town)

By the end of this module, pupils will be able to:

- describe their town
- use quantifiers (some, many, a few)
- tell the time
- order in a café
- use the present tense
- use the immediate future tense

Pupils will do four assessments:

Listening assessment: pupils will have to listen for detail. They should revise the vocabulary provided and do as much practice as possible, for example, by watching cartoons in Spanish or listening to resources on the Internet.

Reading assessment: pupils will have to understand written Spanish to answer some questions from the subtopics outlined above. Pupils will also translate a short paragraph from Spanish into English.

Speaking assessment: Pupils will have to answer some of these questions orally

- a) ¿cómo es tu ciudad? (*what's your town like?*)
- b) ¿te gusta tu ciudad? (*do you like your town?*)
- c) ¿qué vas a hacer en tu ciudad? (*what are you going to do in your town?*)
- d) ¿qué te gustaría tener en tu ciudad? (*what would you like to have in your town?*)

Writing assessment: Pupils will have to write a text in Spanish describing their town. They will also translate some short sentences from English into Spanish.

In order to be successful, pupils should revise the vocabulary provided and do as much practice as possible. Pupils should also revise how to form the present and the immediate tenses, give different opinion phrases and use a wide range of connectives.
